





# Notes on Licensing Options

## Products

- Our main software line is available in three different flavors:
- ▶ PDFlib includes a variety of functions for generating PDF output. (Note that PDFlib Lite, the open-source subset of PDFlib is not available for server-based licensing, but only premium licensing.)
  - ▶ PDFlib+PDI includes all PDFlib functions, plus the PDF Import Library (PDI) for including existing PDF pages in the generated output. It also includes the pCOS interface for querying PDF objects.
  - ▶ PDFlib Personalization Server (PPS) includes PDFlib+PDI, plus functions for automatically filling PDFlib blocks. A PPS license also covers the PDFlib Block Plugin for creating blocks interactively in Adobe Acrobat on Mac and Windows.

A detailed feature comparison is available in the product documentation and on our Web site. PDFlib, PDFlib+PDI, and PPS are distributed as a combined binary which is fully functional, but displays a demo stamp across all generated pages unless a valid license key is applied. The pCOS interface for querying PDF objects is contained in the evaluation versions of PDFlib+PDI and PPS, but is limited to small documents. According to your order the license key will activate PDFlib, PDFlib+PDI, or PPS.

## Support

We offer optional support contracts in combination with a new product license, or to renew an existing support contract. Customers with an active support contract will benefit from the following advantages:

- ▶ technical support with short response times
- ▶ all minor (maintenance) and major (functional) updates included
- ▶ early availability of patchlevel (bugfix) versions
- ▶ maintenance releases and technical support available until the end of a product's lifetime

For a detailed description of support benefits please review the document »PDFlib GmbH support policy« which is available on our Web site. The support fee is 18% of the license fee per year.

## Scope of a License

One license covers a single computer running under the selected operating system platform, regardless of the number of CPUs. Development licenses for machines which are not used for production purposes and run under the same operating system are free with each purchase. Redundant (backup) machines do not require a separate license, provided they are never used concurrently with the actual production machines. Groups of load-balancing servers require a license for every server in the group.

## Operating System Platform

Supplying the name of the target operating system platform is a strict requirement since the license is bound to a specific platform. The license is valid for all supported language bindings (programming languages) on the selected platform.

A separate price list is available for IBM eServer iSeries and zSeries. Note that we can deliver our products for even more platforms than those listed on this form; please contact us for details.

## Volume Discounts

Volume discounts are available for multiple licenses of the same product, provided all licenses are ordered with a single combined order:

- ▶ If 5 or more licenses are ordered, 10% discount off the list price is granted for all licenses.
- ▶ If 10 or more licenses are ordered, 15% discount off the list price is granted for all licenses.

Please contact us for discounts on higher numbers of licenses.

## Updates of older Versions

An update changes an existing license to a license for a newer version on the same platform. An update invalidates the old license. CPU-based licenses for PDFlib 5 and 6 products can be updated at a reduced license fee. Each CPU license for a version 5 or 6 product entitles to an update to a version 7 license. For example, a dual-CPU license can be updated to two version 7 licenses. A valid license key must be supplied with an update order. Maintenance updates (e.g., from version 7.0.1 to 7.0.2) are free.

Customers without a support contract can add support when updating to PDFlib 7. In this case the support fee is based on the full license fee of the product (not the reduced update fee).

The discount for updating PDFlib, PDFlib+PDI, or PPS 5/6 to version 7 is the same for all combinations if the older license has been purchased before October 1, 2006. Licenses acquired after this date can only be updated to the same product (but the product type can be changed by combining the update with an upgrade, see below).

## Upgrades

An upgrade changes an existing license for a PDFlib 7 product to a license for a more advanced product on the same platform. An upgrade invalidates the old license. All licenses can be upgraded at a reduced fee. A valid license key must be supplied with an upgrade order. The following table indicates the fees for various upgrade combinations as a percentage of the target product's list price:

## Premium Licenses

In addition to machine-based licenses we offer licenses with extended rights, such as redistributable license packs, site licenses, and source code licenses. These premium licenses do not require any royalties, and can be combined with support.

Some examples (US-\$ prices are for customers in the Americas, Australia, and Japan; Euro prices for all other regions):

- ▶ PDFlib 7 site license for one platform: starting at US-\$/Euro 10 000
- ▶ PDFlib+PDI 7 site license for one platform: starting at US-\$/Euro 20 000
